





# NEIGHBOURHOOD COMMENTS INFORMING THE DESIGN OF BUILDINGS TWO AND THREE

- 1. Possible Improvements to Mill Street Including improved sidewalks, a landscaped boulevard and new curbs and pavement.
- 2. Reduce the massing of buildings 2 and 3 along Mill Street and Dayfoot by:
  - a. Possibly turning the orientation of the buildings so the "short" side is on Mill Street;
  - b. Providing enhanced landscaping between buildings 2 and 3 and Mill Street (lots of trees);
  - c. Include a courtyard between buildings 2 and 3 that connects the development to Mill Street and opens up the vista from Mill Street through to the park on Dayfoot;
  - d. Possibly turning the orientation of building 3 so the "short" side is on Dayfoot;
  - e. Step back both buildings 2 and 3 along Mill Street and Dayfoot.
- 3. Possibly enhancing the development of the park on Dayfoot once input has been received from the neighbourhood.
- 4. Allowing all three buildings to be built at 6 storeys with appropriate step backs affords Amico the opportunity to include additional items within the development that are meaningful to the neighbourhood.
