# SPRING ARENA SCHEDULE

## Ice Programs

### Public Skating

**Fee:** Child \$2.50 / Adult \$4.00. Open to all ages. Skate aids and strollers not permitted during regular ice season (summer only). CSA approved helmets are highly recommended with chinstraps fastened.

### Family Skating

**Fee:** Child \$2.50 / Adult \$4.00 / Group \$9.50. Open to all ages. A parent or guardian 18 years of age or older must accompany children on the ice. Maximum of 5 participants including one adult. Parent/guardian attending on ice must be accompanied by a child. Free use of skate aids is available at the arena or bring your own. Strollers with clean wheels allowed on the ice. CSA helmets are recommended with chinstraps fastened.

### Family Power Play (NEW!)

Family Power Play fee is \$7.50 per person. This new program is for youth of all ages accompanied by an adult on the ice to develop hockey skills. The ratio of youth to guardian is not to exceed 2:1. Parent/guardian must be 18 years of age and older and must remain on the ice. Parent/guardian must be accompanied by a youth. Multiple parents/guardians may attend. Two nets will be provided.

Body contact, game play, slap shots and practice tools i.e. pylons, scrimmages are not permitted. Full equipment is highly recommended for participants under 18. CSA approved helmets and hockey gloves are mandatory for all participants. All participants, including goalies, are subject to payment. This program is for skills development only and Shinny is not permitted. Please attend our Shinny Programs offered at other times and locations.

### Adult Skating

**Fee:** \$4.00. For people 18 years and older. No hockey sticks or pucks allowed. Figure skaters should register for the figure skating session. During adult skating, no figure skating or hockey skills practice is allowed. CSA approved helmets highly recommended with chinstraps fastened.

### Figure Skating Pick-Up

**Fee:** \$7.50. For experienced figure skaters. Admission is required for all participants, including coaches.

### Parent & Tot Skating

**Fee:** Child \$2.50 / Adult \$4.00. Skating for children under 6 years who are accompanied by an adult on the ice. Child must wear a helmet. No hockey sticks or pucks are allowed. Free use of skate aids is available at the arena or bring your own. Strollers are allowed on the ice if the wheels have been cleaned.

### Parent & Tot Shinny

**Fee:** Child \$2.50 / Adult \$4.00. Children under 6 years who are accompanied by an adult can focus on having fun developing hockey skills. Adults and preschoolers are permitted a stick and puck. For children, full hockey equipment including a CSA approved hockey helmet with face mask is mandatory. For adults, helmets are mandatory but full equipment is optional. Adults are not permitted to shoot or raise the puck in a manner that may be dangerous to others.

### Stick & Puck 12 Years & Under

**Fee:** Child / Adult \$7.50. Work on puck control and skating skills. Shooting of the puck is not allowed other than for passing drills as no hockey nets are provided. Ratio of instructor/coach/parent to child is not to exceed 1:2. Parent/guardian must be 18 years of age or older and must remain in the program area. Parent/guardian

attending on ice must be accompanied by a child. Full protective hockey equipment is highly recommended to be worn at all times by participants. Helmets and gloves are mandatory for all participants. Body contact, rough play, game play, scrimmages and goaltenders are NOT permitted.

### Family Stick & Puck

**Fee:** Child / Adult \$7.50. Open to families of all ages. Work on puck control and skating skills in a family environment. Shooting of the puck is not allowed other than for passing drills as no hockey nets will be provided. Ratio of instructor/coach/parent to child is not to exceed 1:2. Parent/guardian must be 18 years of age or older and must remain in the program area. Parent/guardian attending on ice must be accompanied by a child. Full protective hockey equipment is highly recommended to be worn at all times. Helmets and gloves are mandatory for all participants. Body contact, rough play, game play, scrimmages are NOT permitted.

### Youth Shinny (13-17 years)

**Fee:** Child/Adult \$7.50. Play a fun pick-up game of shinny by dividing players equally based on skill level. Body contact, rough play and slap shots are NOT permitted. Parent/guardian must be 18 years of age or older and must remain in the program area. Goalies are permitted. Full protective hockey equipment must be worn by participants, including a CSA-approved helmet. Games are organized by participants.

### Adult Shinny

**Fee:** \$7.50 (\$11.00 prime time). Persons 18 years or older. Full hockey equipment, including helmets, must be worn. No body contact or rough play is allowed. Games are organized by participants.

### 50+ Shinny

**Fee:** \$7.50. Persons 50 years and over. Full hockey equipment, including helmets, must be worn. No body contact or rough play is allowed. Games are organized by participants.

## Floor Programs

### Pickleball

**Fee:** Adult \$5.00. A fun sport that combines many elements of tennis, badminton, and ping-pong. Beginners welcome! Please bring your own paddle and water bottle with you (glass prohibited).

### Inline Skating

**Fee:** Child \$2.50 / Adult \$4.00 / Group \$9.50. Join in the fun or learn a new skill. Come out and enjoy a low impact workout without the outside elements to worry about. Open to all ages. No stick or balls allowed. Helmets and wrist guards recommended.

### Ball Hockey Shinny

**Fee:** Child \$2.50 / Adult \$4.00. Play a fun pick-up game of shinny by dividing players equally based on skill level. Body contact, rough play and slap shots are NOT permitted. Games are organized by participants. Parent/guardian must be 18 years of age or older and must remain in the program area if not accompanying youth on the floor. Goalies are permitted. Elbow, shoulder and shin pads must be worn by participants including a CSA-approved helmet. Parent/guardian on floor monitoring the activity must wear approved CSA helmet. Adults on the floor are not to participate but are to monitor.
