The Town of Halton Hills is undertaking an assessment for improvements to be made to Eighth Line from Steeles Avenue to Maple Avenue, due to increased population and greater demand on the Town's roads network.

Following an extensive evaluation, the preferred solution is to widen Eighth Line within the Study Area (see map) with improvements made to the existing road infrastructure and active transportation features. Upon completion of the study, an Environmental Study Report (ESR) will be prepared and made available for public review and comment.

Community Input

Consultation is an important part of the project and to ensure opportunities for feedback, the first Public Information Centre (PIC) was held on October 16, 2019 and the second was held virtually through Let's Talk Halton Hills from June 8, 2020 to June 30, 2020.

Join us on June 6, 2022 at 6:30 to 8:30pm for a virtual Open House (via Zoom) featuring a presentation on the project's current status and preferred design concepts. The presentation will be followed by a Question and Answer period.
